



## Mu Ko Surin National Park

Mu Ko Surin National Park is located in the Andaman Sea 60km from mainland Thailand. It has some of the best snorkeling and diving sites in Thailand. The Park opens between 1 November, 2009 and 30 April, 2010.

### Boat to Ko Surin National Park

Daily slow ferry roundtrip: 1,300 Baht per person\*  
Depart Kuraburi Pier 09.00, arrive Ko Surin 11.30  
Return boat depart Ko Surin 13.00, arrive Kuraburi Pier 15.30

Daily speed boat roundtrip: 1,600 Baht per person\*  
Depart Kuraburi Pier 08.30, arrive Ko Surin 09.45  
Return boat depart Koh Surin 14.30, arrive Kuraburi Pier 15.30
