Koh Surin National Park is a paradise of fine white sandy beaches, thick jungle, crystal-clear waters, and some of the best coral reef in Thailand. It is also home of the Moken, a traditionally nomadic sea people who have lived in harmony with nature along Thailand's Andaman coast for thousands of years.

Day 1 Turquoise Bays and Sea Nomads

- 08.00 Depart from Kuraburi to the pier
- **08.30** Register at the National Park entrance and enjoy a coffee break at the pier
- 09.00 Depart from the pier to Surin Island by speed boat
- 12.00 Lunch at the Surin National Park Restaurant
- **13.30** Snorkeling at Sapparot Bay and Bon Bay in the crystal clear waters of the Andaman Sea. Continue to visit the Moken Village
- 15.30 Return to the Surin National Park camping area
- **18.30** Dinner at the National Park restaurant and time to relax at the beach or your private tent

Day 2 Corals and Reefs

- 07.30 Breakfast at the national park restaurant
- 09.00 Take a long-tail boat to Mankorn Island to snorkel in a beautiful reef
- 12.00 Lunch at the Surin National Park Restaurant
- 14.00 Pack and prepare to leave Surin Island
- 15.30 Depart Surin Island by speed boat

16.30 Arrive at Kuraburi Pier and travel on to your next destination *Meals: Breakfast and lunch included*
