




Krabi Local Life- c1e

Trip summary	1 days Klong Lu community bungalows on Koh Klang
Getting there	Tour starts and end at Krabi
In-country support	International support staff, local guide, bilingual Thai/English translator, visitor's handbook
What's included	Transfers during the tour, accommodation, activities and meals as stated in the program
Availability	All year round

Explore the island of Koh Klang with the locals of Klong Lu village and experience the traditional way of life by participating in local fishing, the art of creating batik patterns on cloth and learning the craft of long tail boat making. Then head into nature for mangrove exploration from a long tail boat.

Day 1 Cultural Exchange

- Morning** Start the tour in Krabi, pick up at your hotel to meet your Andaman Discoveries translator for pre-trip briefing, and then heading to the Thara Public Park Pier.
 Hop on a long-tail boat to the island of Koh Klang, were a motorcycle sidecar brings you to the village
 Meet your host families and take a walk through the village or go for a beach relaxing
- Noon** Lunch at the community bungalows' canteen, enjoy authentic Southern Thai food with hosts
 Design your own Patche textiles by painting colourfull florals on a sheer white cloth and keep a souvenir
 Learn the process of long-tail boat making completed and hear fascinating stories from the people that build and use them.
 Experience the traditional processing of Khao Sang Yot, a special germinated brown rice.
 Explore the mangrove forest by long-tail boat with your local guide and learn about this eco-system and its importance to the village
 Transfer to your hotel, end of program.
