Day 1 Natural Wonder

Morning Pick up at your hotel and meet your Andaman Discoveries translator for a pre-trip briefing and cultural orientation

Transfer to Ban Sam Chong Nuea village to meet your local guide, and be welcomed into their way of life

Take a walking tour of the community with your local guide to learn about the history and lives of these villagers.

Meet the women's group who makes beautiful tie-dye creations using natural colors from the surrounding forests. Have an opportunity to learn their techniques and create your own piece to keep as a souvenir.



Noon Lunch - enjoy authentic southern Thai seafood in local restaurant with fresh seafood.

Head into nature, and explore the mangrove forest in a long-tail boat, where you have the chance to spot various birds, monitor lizards and monkeys. Take a fascinating journey through the tidal canals and learn how the villagers are active in protecting this amazing ecosystem.

Continue your journey to the Phang Nga bay the famous island and Panyi village (fisherman village), you will see the dramatic limestone islands, explore sea caves and relax with the breathtaking views.

Return to the village get you natural tie dye back and transfer to Khaolak, end of program
