Village & Island Tour

8.00am Start the tour at your hotel. Meet your translator for a pre-trip briefing and cultural orientation. Transfer 2 hours North to Ban Talae Nok village to meet your local guide, and be welcomed into their way of life.

10.00am Take a walking tour of the community with your local guide to learn about the history and lives of these villagers, see an area of the village that was destroyed by the 2004 tsunami and learn how this event affected the community.

10.15am Take part in a handicraft workshop and learn the art of Batik. You can create your own design or have your hosts draw one of you, then color in the beautiful designs, and keep your creation as a souvenir.

12:00pm Explore the mangrove forest in a long-tail boat, where you have the chance to spot various birds, monitor lizards and monkeys. Take a fascinating journey through the tidal canals and learn how the villagers are active in protecting this amazing ecosystem.

Continue your journey out to the hidden paradise of the undeveloped Gam Islands, only 10 km from the coast of the village. Arrive to the white sand bays and explore the surrounding nature, then go for a swim and snorkel in the clear blue waters

12.30pm Picnic lunch on the island, relax on the beach.

15.00pm Depart the island and say goodbye to your kind hosts.

16:00pm Transfer to your hotel, End of program.
