Explore the Community home stay with the locals of Laem Sak village and experience the traditional way of life by participating in the Orchid conservation project, the art of creating batik patterns on cloth and enjoying the kayak to the sea gypsies cave. Then visit the local fish farm and seaweed farm.

## Day 1 Culture Exchange

#### Morning

Meet your translator at your hotel in Krabi town /Ao Nang area Transfers to Laem Sak Community, Meet your Local Guide at Baan Ao Nam Visiting a wild Orchids farm, learning about the different type of Thai Orchids in the area such as Lady's slipper and Krabi Aerides.

Hop on a long tail boat for the mangrove forest tour and returns a native orchid back to the forest this is the conservation project in the village

#### Noon

Enjoy a local Thai dish "Khao Kluk Kapi" delicious fried rice with shrimp paste. Transfer to Baan Laem Sak, Check into Local Resort

Afternoon activity designs your own Batik textiles by painting colorful designs on a sheer white cloth and keep for souvenir. Village tour, learning about a unique 3 cultures, Buddhist Thais, Chinese Thais, Muslim Thais. That lives peacefully together for more than 100 years

## Day 2 Natural Wonder

### Morning Break

Breakfast at hotel with Thai local food.

Take a kayak tour to see Ancient paintings at Chao Lay or Sea Gyp Sea Cave and enjoying a beautiful area. Stop at a fish and seaweed farm. Learning about local fisheries farm in the area and planting seaweed.

Return to the village, enjoy authentic southern Thai food lunch Pack and say goodbye to your host family.

Transfer to Krabi town or Ao nang, end of program.
