**Service projects 2016**

1. Hilversum: BLC: cement step; paint English dictionary murals on the walls + touch up painting in other areas; new soccer goals and new storage space/ hooks for toothbrush program. Home & life: construction at school grounds (plaster wall, mural painting and river bank reatining wall construction), teach children and share stories. Also did beach clean
2. KIS Bangkok: Culture exchange/ Sports acitvities, community service project: paint nursery, kitchen and canteen walls and English camp.
3. Khiri Travel (Chicago school): planting mangrove seedlings, restoring riverbeds and re-planting water lily.
4. Berkley International School: BLC: leveling the ground

**Service projects 2017**

1. Hilversum: BLC: Paint and cement fence paint murals, playground fix up, plant bushes and trees for shade and fix up the garden and re-plant vegetables. Mangrove Reforestation project: plant sapplings, replant mature sapplings, pick sapplings to plant in nursery and prepare sapplings in nursery.

**Service projects 2018**
