Krabi Nurturing Nature

Half Day or one day Program

In the morning Enjoy rafting through the morning mist while taking a sip of coffee with Thai local dessert and breakfast, watching the variety of bird to come out and listening to the local community music along the Nong Talae reservoir.

Bike tour to visit the traditional Thai house more than 100 years old, swimming in the Klong Nam Sai (clear water stream) and then enjoy the traditional Thai lunch with local village.





Na Teen Ao Nang Krabi

Ban NaTeen village is located in beautiful Ao Nang, Krabi Province, about 14 kilometers away from Krabi town.

There are 14 homestays, 86 community members and English speaking local guides that create culturally immersive activities, learning about their local way of life.

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One Day Tour Program

In the morning learn how to tap rubber trees with the local farmers, make a tasty traditional Thai dessert and learn to cook Thai food with the local community. Then, learn from the local occupational group about all the uses of coconuts, from grating a raw coconut, to making coconut milk for cooking and then using the shell to make key chains or bracelets. Then paint the batik cloth and keep your creation as a souvenir. In the afternoon, visit the herbal garden and learn about plant traditional uses. With the local community, head to the mangrove forest for a crab fishing activity.





Prai Wi Tee Garden

One Day Tour Program

Visit the herbal garden learn how to living with the nature in the mangrove forest with the local farmers, learn about the plants traditional uses, make a tasty traditional Thai dessert and learn to cook Thai jungle food with the local community in the forest. Then, learn to weaving traditional roofing panels out of Nypa Palm leaf, fishing crab in the mangrove forest, making Thai dessert with the palm leave in the forest.



Tung YeePeng Lanta

Tung Yee Peng is a strong CBT group in Koh Lanta Krabi, Be welcomed into their daily life by learning about their mangrove forest protection and the way of life. Enjoy a relaxing traditional local gondora ride through the mangroves and learn to cook Thai food with your host.

Community Tour, Koh Lanta

Half day Tour -
Morning or Afternoon,

Pick up at your hotel in Koh Lanta, arrive at the community center for a pre trip briefing and cultural orientation with your local guide Hop on a traditional boat and head to the mangrove forest, explore along the way and stop for fishing clams or local fish.

Depending on the ocean tide, look at the colorful of fiddler crab. Take a walking tour of the nature trail learn and about the ecological system in the area with your local guide. Transfer by local motorcycle taxi to the homestay host and cook a meal with the calms and fish you found.

Enjoy your meal and then transfer to your hotel, end of program.
