Learning Objectives

- Study the key cultural, economic, and sustainability issues of these coastal communities

- Study the biodiversity and interrelatedness of the eco-systems in the region including mangroves, beaches, tropical rainforests, coral reefs, and estuaries.
- Explore the interrelation of community development, coastal ecology, natural resource use, and conservation (e.g. traditional livelihoods and culture, tourism, community organizing, and environmental action).
- Experiential learning of analytical concepts such as sustainability, gender equity, and community vulnerability/resilience.
- Access a community's knowledge base on disaster management, natural resources, and traditional livelihoods.
